

Statutory Holidays

Statutory holidays are days when most people receive the day off with pay. The compensation you receive will generally be a percentage of the net pay you earned in the weeks preceding the statutory holiday though there are eligibility criteria that must first be met. Please refer to your province's Employment Standards website for information pertaining to eligibility for statutory holiday pay and details of how it will be calculated.

1 Flexible Statutory Holiday:

As your 10th Statutory Holiday in 2025, please choose one of the following days & email admin@platinumtechnologiesinc.ca by no later than January 31st, 2025, with your selection. Please note that you must have approval from your onsite supervisor before communicating your selection.

- Family Day February 17 (Monday)
- Islander Day (PEI) February 17 (Monday)
- Heritage Day (Nova Scotia) February 17 (Monday)
- Easter Monday April 21 (Monday)
- Saint-Jean-Baptiste Day June 24 (Tuesday)
- Civic Holiday / New Brunswick Day August 4 (Monday)
- National Day for Truth & Reconciliation September 30 (Tuesday)

Also, please note that if your choice results in not being able to work on the alternate day, that day will be treated as a day off without pay or a vacation day. (For example, if you choose to take the civic holiday in August but your work site is closed on either Family Day or Easter Monday, that day will be a day off without pay or a vacation day.)
