

Statutory Holidays

Statutory holidays are days when most people receive the day off with pay. The compensation you receive will generally be a percentage of the net pay you earned in the weeks preceding the statutory holiday though there are eligibility criteria that must first be met. Please refer to your province's Employment Standards website for information pertaining to eligibility for statutory holiday pay and details of how it will be calculated.

- New Year's Day - January 1 (Thursday)
- Good Friday – April 3 (Friday)
- Victoria Day / National Patriots' Day - May 18 (Monday)
- Canada Day - July 1 (Wednesday)
- Labour Day - September 7 (Monday)
- Thanksgiving Day - October 12 (Monday)
- Remembrance Day – November 11 (Wednesday)
- Christmas Day - December 25 (Friday)
- Boxing Day – December 26 (Saturday) – Lieu Day = December 28 (Monday)

1 Flexible Statutory Holiday:

As your 10th Statutory Holiday in 2026, please choose one of the following days & email admin@platinumtechnologiesinc.ca by no later than January 31st, 2026, with your selection. Please note that you must have approval from your onsite supervisor before communicating your selection.

- Family Day - February 16 (Monday)
- Islander Day (PEI) - February 16 (Monday)
- Heritage Day (Nova Scotia) – February 16 (Monday)
- Louis Riel Day (Manitoba) – February 16 (Monday)
- Easter Monday – April 6 (Monday)
- Saint-Jean-Baptiste Day – June 24 (Wednesday)
- Civic Holiday / New Brunswick Day – August 3 (Monday)
- National Day for Truth & Reconciliation – September 30 (Wednesday)

Also, please note that if your choice results in not being able to work on the alternate day, that day will be treated as a day off without pay or a vacation day. (For example, if you choose to take the civic holiday in August but your work site is closed on either Family Day or Easter Monday, that day will be a day off without pay or a vacation day.)

Working on a Statutory Holiday

Please note that if you choose to work on a statutory holiday, you will be required to select an alternate day off. This alternate day will be treated as a paid day off in lieu of the statutory holiday.
